

## **Kids' book charity completed for Paradise Kids**

Queensland brother and sister Hannah and Luke Sinclair have completed a charity book project for Gold Coast-based organisation Paradise Kids.

The 36-page book, which features stories from children and parents who have suffered loss or grief, will be printed this week.

"The six stories are quite emotional but we have worked with the writers to also have some words in each story which give hope to others who may have suffered similar tragedies," Hannah, 16, said.

"The project has taken eight months and we will be delighted to hand over all copies of the book to Paradise Kids next week."

Luke said a Nerang printing firm called Fast Proof Press had kindly agreed to print the book for free.

"We were delighted when Robert (Fast Proof Press) said he would print the book as that was the final part of the project for us – to find a place to print it," Luke, 13, said.

"We hope Paradise Kids gets lots of publicity out of the project and also sells the books to raise money."

In 2007, Hannah and Luke set up a website – [www.hannahluke.com](http://www.hannahluke.com) – and put their pet rock Oscar on the site. Their plan was to 'trade' their rock for a new car for a Brisbane charity called Youngcare.

Just 16 weeks later, they had traded their way to a \$41,000 car for Youngcare.
